

Election Schedule

Spring Primary – the primary held the 3rd Tuesday in February to nominate non-partisan candidates to be voted for at the spring election; held only when the number of candidates for an elected office exceeds twice the number to be elected to the office.

Spring Election – the election held on the first Tuesday in April to elect non-partisan judicial, educational, municipal and county officers and to express preference for the person to be the presidential candidate for each party in a year in which electors for President and Vice President are to be elected.

Partisan Primary – the primary held the 2nd Tuesday in August to nominate candidates to be voted for at the general election.

General Election – the election held in even-numbered years on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November to elect U. S. Senators, Representatives in Congress, Presidential Electors, State Senators, Representatives to the Assembly, District Attorneys, State Officers other than the State Superintendent and Judicial Officers, and County Officers other than Supervisors and County Executives.
