OLD BUSINESS

A. Park Conditions

It was noted that the City of Menasha does patrol everything to the west shore of Little Lake Butte des Morts or the edge of Fritse Park. It was noted that the city staff will maintain the trails each Monday, and the town staff will review the trail each Friday.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Elect new Vice-President

President Glen Allen addressed the Commission members with the vacancy created by the passing Commissioner Richard Gawinski. Nominations from the floor were requested. MOTION: by Commissioner Herb Horn, seconded by Commissioner Judy Holtz to nominate Commissioner Clarence Peterson as Vice President. Two additional requests were made for nominations, hearing none, motion carried with all in favor.

B. Fritse Park Pavilion

The Town of Menasha has received the insurance settlement in the amount of \$9,926 for the damage done at the Fritse Park Pavilion. Director Kading prepared an estimate itemizing the expenses to repair / remove the pavilion through Spring of 2006. Discussion ensued. MOTION: by Commissioner Herb Horn, seconded by Commissioner Clarence Peterson to recommend the Town Board amend the 2005 budget to expend the insurance settlement money and raze the Fritse Park shelter in 2005 and complete site restoration in 2006. Motion carried unanimously.
