Take pride in your neighborhood by keeping your garbage and recycling carts out of sight!

Garbage is collected every week. Recyclables are collected every other week.

The following curbside services occur **on your garbage day** (as shown on the calendar):

- Recyclables Collection (indicated as "A" or "B")
- Yard Waste Collection
- Chipping Program
- Christmas Tree Collection
- Leaf Collection

HOL Holiday - No Pick-Up

- Monday Holiday Weeks: Tues.-Fri. collection will be Wed.-Sat.
- All other holidays, collection will be the following day

HHW Household Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep Program - see reverse for details

Carts must be placed at the street prior to 6:30 am on your pickup day

TREE and BRUSH CHIPPING

The policy and program can be found on the town's website at <http://www.town-menasha.com/StreetWeb/chipping.htm> and on Page 7 in the **IMPORTANT INFORMATION** brochure that was distributed with the automated carts.

- Materials will be collected on your regular garbage collection day.
- Tree and brush material must be placed curbside by 6:30 am, but no earlier than 48 hours prior to your regular garbage collection day.
- In the event town crews cannot complete the collection route on your scheduled day, collection will continue that week until the routes are completed.
- If professional services are used to cut down large amounts of trees or bush, they shall remove the materials.
- Place brush piles in a single row with all cut ends toward the road; piles shall not exceed 5 feet in height; branches cannot exceed 6 inches in diameter, but keep the branches long for the safety of our crew.
- If you missed your scheduled pick up, you can take the material to the drop-off center on E. Shady Ln.

- Violation of the Tree and Brush Chipping Policy will be tagged. Failure to remove such material within 24 hours could result in a citation being issued for violation of Ordinance 10.03(7).

YARD WASTE AND LEAF COLLECTION

- Occurs every other week, on your garbage day, as indicated on the calendar.
- Yard Waste includes bundled twigs and sticks (bundles are not to exceed 4 feet in length, 2 feet in diameter and must weigh less than 50 pounds), stumps, roots or shrubs with intact root balls, clean woody vegetative material no greater than 6 inches in diameter and garden debris.
- Use biodegradable paper bags or containers with lifting handles (30 gallon capacity).
- Untied plastic bags should be used as a last resort when preparing leaves for pick up, as they are not biodegradable.
- Grass clippings are **not** collected curbside. Bagged clippings must be transported to the County landfill in Oshkosh.

CART PLACEMENT

- Must be 3-5 feet from each other and from any obstacle (mailbox, tree, vehicle, etc.)
- Must be placed curbside by 6:30 am (placed curbside the night before is recommended)
- The front of the cart (where the serial number is printed) must face the road
- Lids must close completely when placing the carts for collection.
- If your cart is tagged for a violation, your cart will not be collected until the next scheduled collection.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Please refer to the Town of Menasha Automated Collection of Garbage and Recyclables brochure; watch "The Bridge" for updates.

- Reminder - Please do not place your recyclables in plastic bags! All recyclables must be placed loose in the recycling cart.
- Plastic motor oil bottles and plastic bags are NOT recyclable. Please throw these items in the trash!
- Excess paper and cardboard Recyclables can be dropped off (at no charge) in the crates at:
Paper Valley Recycling - 1420 Earl Street Menasha Mon.-Fri. between 7:00 am - 3:30 pm

Used Engine Oil Drop-Off Site

- Clean used engine oil only
- Drop off site is open 24/7
- Drop off site is monitored by security cameras
- You **MUST** take your empty containers only



The drop-off site is located on the west side of the Municipal Complex. Look for the large, white holding tank.
